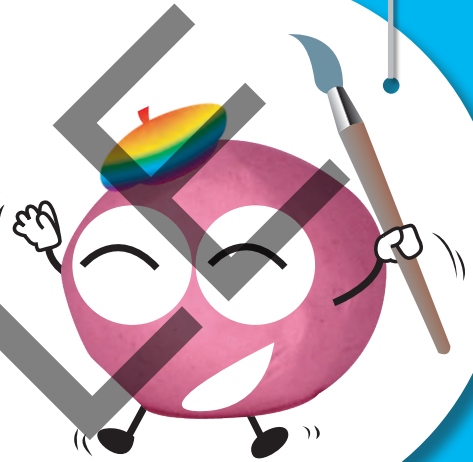

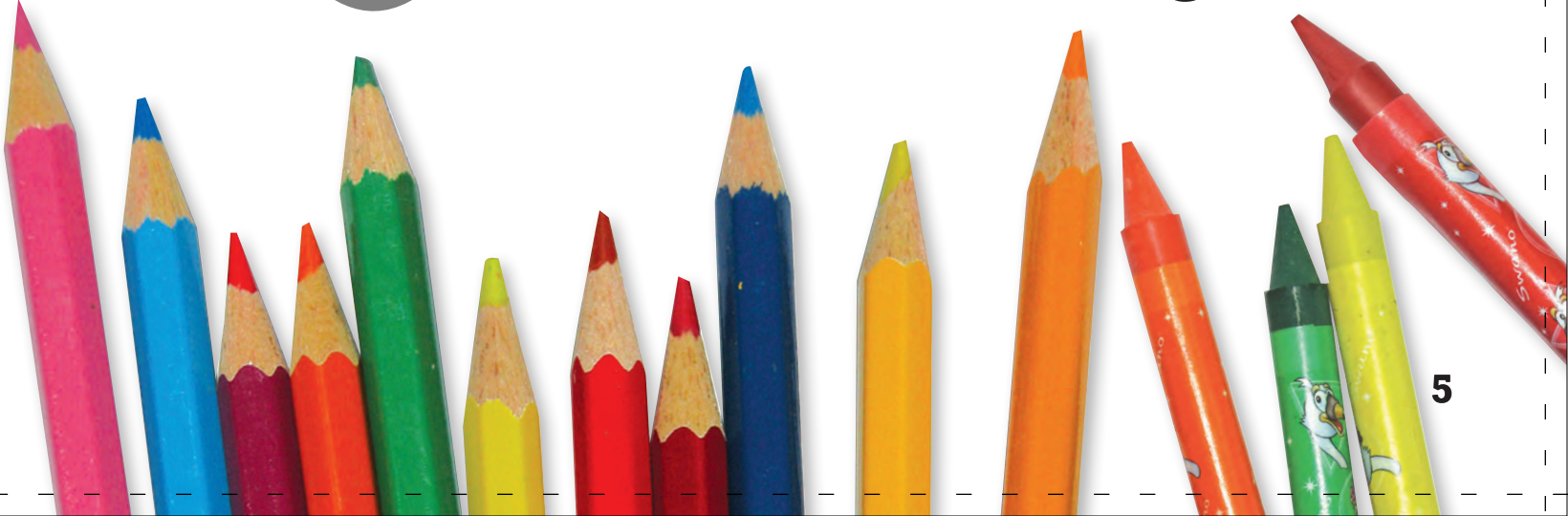
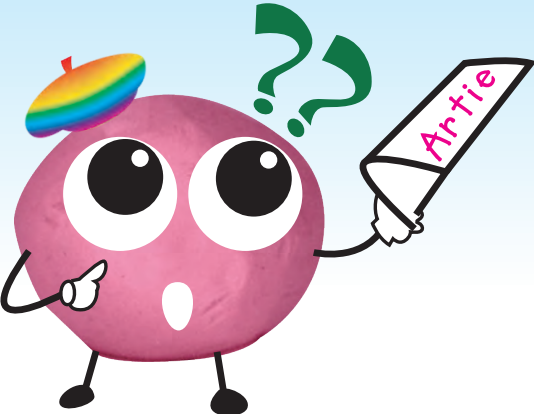

Where shall I place my nameplate?

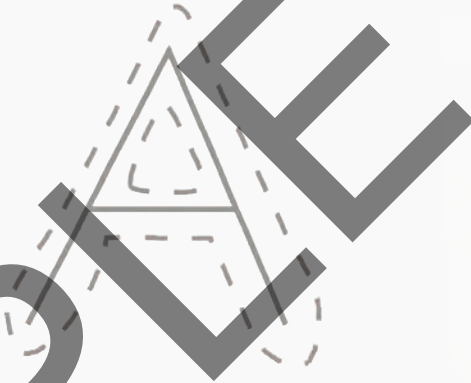


Learn to 'balloon up' a letter using the steps below.

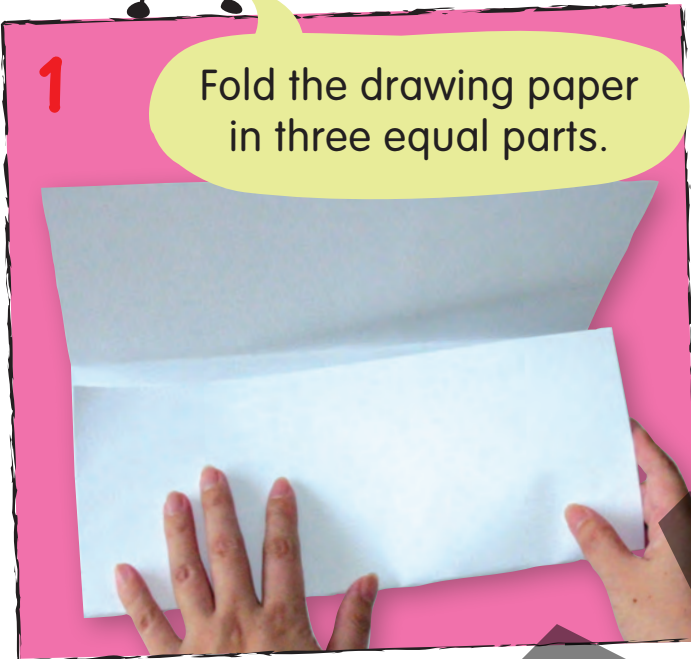
# My Nameplate

## Things You Need

- Drawing paper
- Pencil and eraser
- Fine marker
- Colour pencils

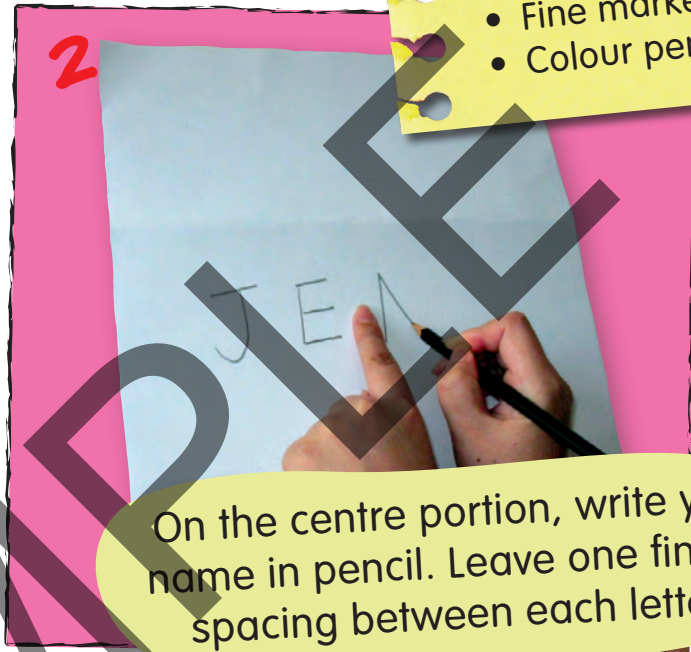

Fold the drawing paper in three equal parts.



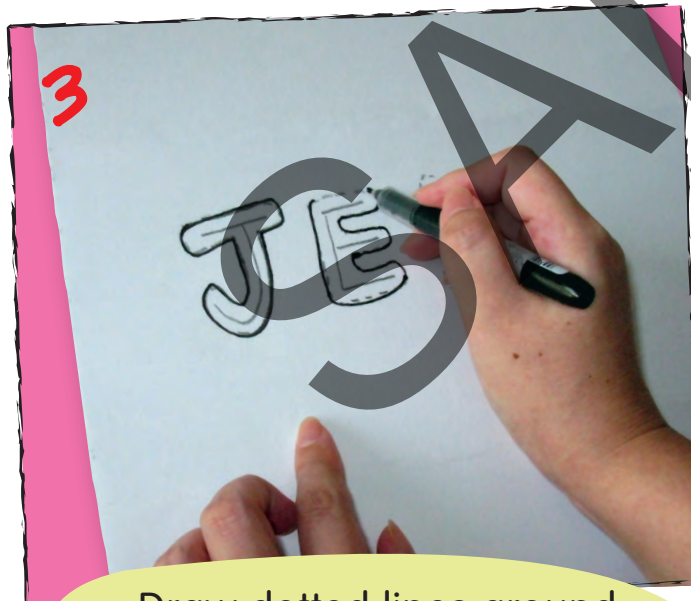

On the centre portion, write your name in pencil. Leave one finger-spacing between each letter.



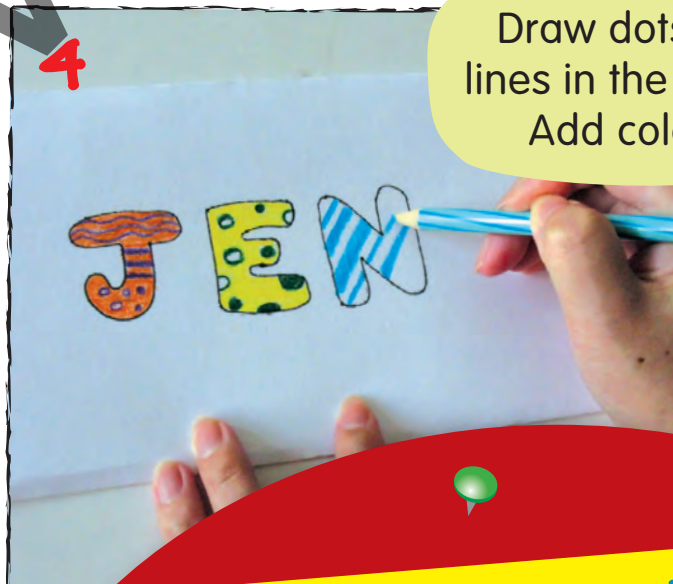

Draw dotted lines around the letters. Join the dotted lines. Go over with a fine marker. Erase the pencil lines.
